2011 HHSC Dressage Show Entry Form

The entry period for each show will open 30 days prior to show date (May 26th, June 23rd, and August 11th), and must be received 6 days before the show (June 19th, July 17th, and September 4th). Entries will be processed on a first come first served basis until the show fills. After the closing date failure to show an entry constitutes forfeiture of entry fees, unless show management receives a Veterinarian Certificate stating that horse is unable to compete. Check paid in full must accompany the entry form. Post entries at show will be accepted as scratches and availability allow (note \$5 additional fee per entry). Management reserves the right to combine or split classes as warranted by entries. Ribbons awarded to 6th place. **Ride times will be emailed the Thursday before the show.** Show conducted according to USDF and USEF rules. No stabling available. Competitors work out of their horse trailer or car and must attend to their horses at all times. Dogs must be kept on a leash and in control at all times. Please leave parking area clean. All riders, regardless of age, must wear correctly fitting ASTM/SEI certified headgear while mounted, no exceptions. Formal show attire is not required; a neat turn out is expected. All riders must wear appropriate footwear. An English type saddle with stirrups is required. One horse/rider combination per class will be placed, using the first score ridden. One horse/rider combination per entry form please.

* Dressage Seat Equitation Class will be conducted according to the following specifications. Medium walk, working trot (sitting or rising) and canter both ways of the ring, movements shall be performed by the exhibitors simultaneously; however, the judge may ask for independent movements or additional movements. The rider's position, seat and specifically the correct use and effect of the aids will be evaluated. Whips and spurs are allowed, horses to be shown in plain snaffle. Groups may be divided into smaller sections, at the discretion of the judge and show management, for safety and convenience. Judges may limit the number of horses required to canter at the same time, at their discretion. Only the rider is judged, however, lameness of horses will be penalized. Judges will evaluate participants and assign scores for each movement, class placing will reflect the total score of each rider for all movements. If classes are held in a standard size dressage arena, no more than 6 horses will be asked to canter at the same time.
